REQUIREMENTS

Skills/Experience

- Love for the Society
- A desire to make ADPS better
- A willingness to volunteer your time
- That's it!

Time Commitment

- Minimum 1.5 hours/month for monthly Board meetings
- Attendance at Convention and inperson Board meetings*
- Typically governors serve for 3 years

*Virtual attendance is always an option!

Eligibility to Run

- Must not be an undergraduate
- There are no upper or lower age limits
- Yes, you can nominate yourself!

WHAT DOES A GOVERNOR DO?

As a collective, the Board of Governors

- Sets a long-term vision for the Society
- Guides the operations of the Society with a collaborative, solutions-oriented mindset
- Supports our affiliates, chapters, and graduate organizations
- Oversees our finance, fundraising, and legal teams

As individuals, a governor may

- Join committees that drive our monthly operations
- Lead new initiatives or task forces
- Serve as chapter liaisons

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SUBMIT A NOMINATION?



The Nominations Committee will contact every person submitted to see if they are interested in running. The expectations of a Governor will be explained at that time, along with the details of the process.



The Nominations Committee will generate a list of 4 to 8 potential candidates from those who accept their nomination, and present it to the Board.



The Board will vote on each potential candidate, and anyone receiving 9 or more "Yes" votes will be a Candidate.



At Convention, the delegates will elect 4 Governors from the list of Candidates.
